**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MOUND CITY CODE REGARDING  
NOXIOUS WEEDS BETWEEN THE PROPERTY LINE AND CURB**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUND DOES ORDAIN:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Mound City Code Section 42-4 is hereby amended as set forth below to add the underlined language.

**Sec. 42-4. Same—Affecting peace and safety.**

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- (10) Noxious weeds, as that term is defined in Minn. Stat. § 18.77, any excessive or uncontrolled growth of other weeds, and un-mowed turfgrass exceeding eight (8) inches in height on all property owned or occupied by a person and on land outside the traveled portion of a public street, sidewalk, or alley abutting such property. Establishment and minimal maintenance of native and naturally-occurring woodland, prairie, wetland, and riparian grasses, wildflowers, and pollinator attractant areas within lots is permissible on unimproved lots in whole or on portions of improved lots, subject to control of noxious and invasive weeds;

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**SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect January 1, 2027 and after publications as required by law.
