CEMETERY MAINTENANCE

From May through October, when mowing is needed, the City requires a maintenance agreement for memorial planters other than the gravestone.

This is meant to facilitate efficient mowing. Memorial planters need to be temporarily moved during the mowing process, which adds time to the process. It is a way to know that the memorials that are there are being tended to by an owner.

This agreement allows the applicant to place a planter at the above grave site for the months indicated above (May through October).

The applicant agrees to maintain the planter in an aesthetically pleasing manner and acknowledges that the Cemetery Official may remove the planter if it is not maintained.

The planter shall not exceed 12" x 12" and shall not be installed temporarily on a stand or at ground level. The weight of the planter box shall not exceed 15 pounds.

The applicant acknowledges the caretaker may remove the planter during routine ground maintenance.

The applicant agrees that if there is any damage or loss to the planter, whether accidental, due to vandalism, or caused by natural forces, the City will not be held responsible for the cost of repairing or replacing the planter.

The cost of the maintenance permit is \$15.00 per month. The payment is due before the installation of the planter.
