

**NOTICE OF MOUND CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING
TO CONSIDER AMENDMENTS TO CITY CODE CHAPTER 129 (ZONING) PERTAINING
TO CORNER LOTS, PARKING STALL DESIGN STANDARDS, AND HUMANE PET STORES**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Mound City Council, as part of its regular meeting being held on **Tuesday, May 26, 2026 at 6:00 p.m.**, or as soon as possible thereafter, in the Council Chambers in the Centennial Building located at 5341 Maywood Road, Mound, MN, will hold a public hearing to consider proposed amendments to City Code Chapter 129 (Zoning.)

The proposed changes to City Code Chapter 129 (Zoning) include modifications to definitions and wording of the requirements for corner lot setbacks and corner lot minimum yard standards to simplify and clarify the application of the code; updates to the minimum required stall size and access aisle for handicapped parking stalls to align with State guidelines; and the addition of definitions and a new section pertaining to humane pet stores, prohibiting pet stores from selling dogs and cats to prevent inhumane breeding conditions.
