# Construction Process

---

- Remove existing items (roadways, sidewalks, curb)
- Set up temporary water service lines
- Prepare and lay out new pipe
- Excavate to existing watermain at ends
  - Trenchless replacement of the watermain
    - Pipe bursting and directional drilling methods
  - Some areas to be replaced by open excavation
- Test the new mains
- Excavate and replace the existing water services
- Restore disturbed areas



# Notification Process

---

- Flyers on front door/entrance
  - Handed out 1-2 days before the next stage of work
  - Additional time for more disruptive activities
- Website updates
- Text alerts through RAVE (emergencies)
- Traffic signs, including message boards



# Project Staging

- Contractor will work from Stage 4 to Stage 1
- Expected start in May
